

#### The Financial Working Group

The setting up of the financial working group was agreed at this year's 2023 AGM. The members of the group are representatives from the committee, stores and the RAA membership and all have financial expertise. They have met a number of times, analysing our overall spend, outgoings and income and have written a comprehensive report which will be circulated to the membership. Their report was approved at the August committee meeting. As a result, we have a working budget for the next financial year 2023/24, an agreed plot rent rise from October and some suggestions on managing our finances going forward. Many thanks to the group all for their hard work and expertise.

It may not be for everyone but its main ethos to feed the soil from above by an annual layer of 2cm of compost supports soil health by not disturbing the teaming subterranean life below the soil's surface.
